## Rules:

1. Mail your entry form to Anne Daino, P.O. Box 32, Owls Head, NY 12969 or email form to [annedaino@gmail.com](mailto:annedaino@gmail.com)
2. Exhibitors must bring an opened bag of King Arthur Flour or submit a UPC code from the flour bag when he/she submits the entry.
3. Adult Contest: Apple Pie - any recipe of your choosing.
  - a. One 9 or 10" double crusted pie **NO LATTICE TOP**
  - b. Apple must be the main ingredient. You may include any other fruit or ingredient.Junior Contest: Apple Crisp - any recipe of your choosing.
  - a. One 8" or 9" square pan
  - b. Apple must be the main ingredient. You may include any other fruit or ingredient.
4. All entries must be submitted in a disposable pan inside a zipper plastic bag. You may submit your baked good in your favorite dish or pan, but you must be there to pick it up on 9/23.
5. Exhibitors must include a recipe card with the complete recipe plus your name and address.
6. All entries must be **completely cooled**. No hot or warm items will be accepted.

## 7. Judging criteria:

Pie: Appearance and Creativity	25 points	Apple Crisp: Appearance and Creativity	25 points
Crust	25 points	topping	25 points
Filling	25 points	fruit filling	25 points
Overall taste	25 points	overall taste	25 points
